MEMBER BENEFITS



- **BROCHURE DISPLAYED AT THE VISITOR INFORMATION CENTER** – Open 7 days a week, 360 days per year. Our knowledgeable volunteers greet nearly 20,000 visitors each year, giving directions, and referring them to your business or organization.
- **WEBSITE LISTING** – Members are listed on the Chamber website. Over 46,000 unique visits are logged yearly. Add a picture/logo with your text listing. \$50 per year for one picture or \$100 for 2-4 pictures.
- **NEWSLETTER ANNOUNCEMENTS** – Members may submit information about an event or business update which may be included without charge as membership news. The newsletter reaches over 6,000 households through the Sequim Gazette's distribution.
- **NEWSLETTER INSERTS** – Members may place a brochure into the Chamber's monthly electronic newsletter. The cost is \$75, you provide the .jpg or .pdf or .doc (350 KB max) and we email out to over 650 email addresses.
- **EVENT LISTINGS** – Members have the opportunity to list their upcoming events on the Chamber website. These events are linked in our weekly E-News and if submitted by a monthly deadline are printed in our newsletter.
- **ACCESS TO THE MEMBER INFORMATION CENTER (MIC)** – Members have the exclusive access to our Member Information Center with added tools and benefits.
- **NETWORKING OPPORTUNITIES** – including bimonthly Chamber Luncheons, monthly After Hours events, bimonthly Networking Breakfasts, an annual Business Showcase Expo, and other training/education opportunities throughout the year.
- **GRAND OPENING/OPEN HOUSE/RIBBON CUTTING** – Want to invite the community to visit your business? The Chamber can help you by providing advertising, ribbon and scissors, and a picture in Chamber newsletter help to boost your exposure in the community.
- **KIOSK ADVERTISING AT THE VISITOR INFORMATION CENTER** – Tourism-related members may advertise in an outdoor kiosk at the Visitor Information Center for a yearly cost of \$200 for a small space or \$400 for a large space.
- **WEBSITE BUTTON ADVERTISING** – Give your business a front page advantage by purchasing a button ad on the Chamber's website. The cost is \$50 per month – Discounted to \$500 per year for a full year.
- **RELOCATION INQUIRY LIST** – Purchase the list of people contacting the Chamber for relocation information. This list is sent monthly via e-mail for a yearly cost of \$100.
- **LUNCHEON SPONSORSHIP** – Be featured in the monthly newsletter and e-newsletters. As a sponsor, your business or organization will have 5 minutes to tell members about your business, new products or services, and have a display table. Cost: \$125 which includes one free lunch. Please provide a gift for a business card drawing (approx. \$25 value).
